WHAT IS CAREERS HIVE?

Careers Hive is an education event by Edinburgh Science. It provides 11–14 year-olds an immersive introduction to the future of work. It highlights the breadth of opportunities available if they continue to engage with STEM subjects (science, technology, engineering and maths) throughout their education.

Careers Hive 2024 will take place in the National Museum of Scotland, Edinburgh from 28 October–2 November. Throughout the week 3,000 students will be guided through three-hour sessions featuring an interactive exhibition, hands-on workshops, and inspirational talks.

We aim to provide students with an exciting and memorable experience, and inspire their thinking about what is possible with their careers, which is where our volunteers come in.
