The Edinburgh Science Festival has lots of friendly staff who can help you. They wear different colour t-shirts depending on what their job is but they are all here to help.

This is Andrew

Andrew is the main person in the Rocket Show.



He will be chatting all about how to make a really good rocket...and sometimes being very silly!

This is Charlie

Sometimes she will pretend to be cross with Andrew



She will shout at him from the audience,
but don't worry – in real life they are
friends!

She'll be sitting on the side of the room
furthest from the door, and will not mind if
you would rather not sit near her.

Some bits are noisy
