What's going on?

Paper airplanes fly because your throw gives it thrust, pushing the plane fowards. The wings give the plane lift, pushing it upwards. However, drag and gravity try to stop the plane from flying.


Force: A push or a pull from one thing to another


Thrust: The force pushing things forwards


Drag: The force from the air that makes things move slower


Lift: The force from wings pushing something up


Gravity: The force from from the Earth pulling things down











