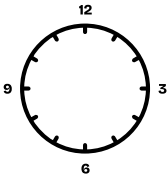

Torches

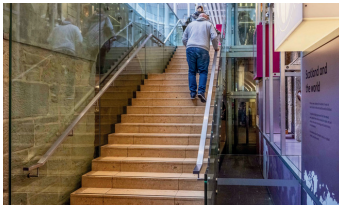


Sunglasses

Or I might be able to eat my own snack or lunch in the lunch room on Level 0 at the Entrance Hall.

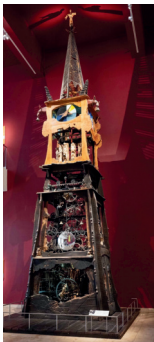
Lunch Space is open from 10am to 5pm
